This letter is to notify you that the Illinois Student Assistance Commission (ISAC) has received the information you reported on the *Free Application for Federal Student Aid* (FAFSA) for the 2009-10 academic year. By filing the FAFSA, you not only applied for federal financial aid but you also applied for a Monetary Award Program (MAP) grant and a Silas Purnell Illinois Incentive for Access (IIA) grant. The MAP and IIA grants are programs of the State of Illinois and are administered by ISAC.

Only if you are eligible will an estimated MAP grant and/or IIA grant for 2009-10 appear on your financial aid award letter from your Illinois MAP-approved college [as long as the college is reported as one of the college choices on your 2009-10 federal *Student Aid Report* (SAR)]. The award letter from the college will be your only notification as to whether you will be receiving a MAP and/or IIA grant for 2009-10.

Information about Eligibility for a MAP Grant the IIA Grant

Eligibility for a MAP grant depends on several factors, including each student's family income, the costs at the college, and accurate and complete information provided on the FAFSA. To receive a MAP grant, the student must attend an Illinois MAP-approved college and that college must be listed as one of the college choices on the federal *Student Aid Report* (SAR). A list of all Illinois MAP-approved colleges can be accessed online at **collegezone.com**. Please refer to the enclosed *2009-10 Monetary Award Program (MAP) Rights and Responsibilities* for a more complete listing of eligibility requirements. The amount of the grant depends on the number of eligible applicants, certain costs at the college, and funding levels each academic year. Reductions to the amount of announced grants are possible.

Eligibility for an IIA grant depends on your family income and your class level. Only freshmen are eligible for this award. Please refer to the enclosed *Silas Purnell Illinois Incentive for Access (IIA) Program Information* document for more information about this grant.

Explanation of YOUR MAP PAID CREDIT HOURS USED

The total number of MAP Paid Credit Hours that you have used is listed in the field entitled "YOUR MAP PAID CREDIT HOURS USED" at the top of this letter. Please pay special attention to the "Tracking MAP Usage" section of the *2009-10 Monetary Award Program (MAP) Rights and Responsibilities*. Please note that any payments processed on your behalf after the "AS OF" date listed above will increase the number of "YOUR MAP PAID CREDIT HOURS USED" as reported on this letter.

Filing Deadline for 2010-11 Academic Year – Apply Early

In order to be considered for a full-year MAP grant for the next academic year, the federal processor must receive the 2010-11 FAFSA no later than August 15, 2010. Please be aware that grant funding could be depleted before this date. Applicants may file electronically with FAFSA on the Web at **fafsa.ed.gov** but not before January 1, 2010.
