

2010-11 IVG Payment Results Extract File Layout Specifications

Overview

After Illinois Veteran Grant (IVG) payment requests are processed, schools have access to review payment results in multiple ways. IVG payment results records may be viewed online through screens and reports, or result records can be retrieved in an 80-byte flat file format by using the Payment Results File Extract Option in IVG Payment via My Zone.

The following 80-byte record layout and description is used for the IVG Payment Results File extract in the IVG Payment via My Zone Web application.

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Definition of Data Elements:

Alpha/Numeric fields (X) greater than one character (byte) are left justified and padded with spaces. Numeric fields (9) greater than one digit (byte) are right justified and padded with zeros.

<u>Field Number</u>	<u>Field Name and Description</u>
1	Claim Record ID – 1 alpha/numeric character; contains the value described below: E = Claim Record
2.	Type of Claim – 1 numeric character; contains a value described below: A = Initial (new) claim or previously rejected claim not paid for the year and term. R = Replacement claim/Adjustment to a previously paid claim
3	IVG School Code - 3 numeric characters; the schools 3-digit IVG code.
4	Term Date – 2 alpha/numeric characters; the two –digit designation for the year and the month for which the claim was requested; yymm format (e.g., September 2010 = 0910)
5	SSN – 9 numeric characters; student’s SSN
6	Program Type – 1 alpha/numeric character. Contains the value described below: V = Illinois Veteran Grant Program
7	Student’s IVG Number – 9 alpha/numeric characters; contains student’s IVG number.
8	Name – 11 alpha/numeric characters. Contains the student’s full last name followed by a space then the first name within the spaces provided (e.g., Johnny Johnson = Johnson Joh)
9	Filler - 1 – 1 alpha/numeric character. Will always be blank.
10	Prorate hours – 1 alpha/numeric character; contains a value as described below: P = Prorated Hours
11	Credit Hours – 4 numeric characters. The number of credit hours associated with this payment (12 hours – 1200, 8.5 hours = 0850).
12	Tuition and Fee Amount to be Paid – 7 numeric characters. The total dollar amount requested (\$1250.50 = 0125050).
13	Tuition and Fee Category Code – 2 alpha/numeric characters. The tuition and fee code applicable to the student’s claim for the term as provided by ISAC (X1 – Summer Term 2010-11, Y1 – Fall Term 2010-11, Z1 – Spring Term 2010-11).

14	In-district / Out-Of-District Indicator – 1 alpha/numeric character; contains a value as described below: I = In-district O = Out-Of-District
15	Filler – 2 – 10 alpha/numeric characters; reserved for ISAC use.
16	Filler – 3 – 12 alpha/numeric characters; reserved for ISAC use.
17	ISAC Mainframe Error Code – 2 alpha/numeric characters; ISAC use only.
18	ISAC Default-Bypass Code – 1 alpha/numeric character; ISAC use only.
