

2011-12 ILLINOIS NATIONAL GUARD (ING) GRANT PROGRAM NOTICE OF RESTRICTED ELIGIBILITY

The Illinois Student Assistance Commission (ISAC) has determined that you are eligible, with the above restriction, for the 2011-12 Illinois National Guard (ING) Grant Program at the college listed above. The academic year for this program begins with the 2011 fall term and ends with the 2012 summer term. Your college will prorate your eligibility based on the above date and you are responsible for the remaining costs. (An "until" date indicates a discharge date upon which benefits cease. An "after" date indicates the one year anniversary in the ING on which benefits begin.)

It is your responsibility to contact your ING unit with any questions regarding your restricted eligibility status, provided to ISAC by the Department of Military Affairs Illinois (DMAIL), Education/Incentives Branch. Any updates to your status (such as re-enlistment) must be submitted to ISAC by DMAIL.

Your college may require a copy of this letter. It is your responsibility to ensure that the financial aid office has received notification of your eligibility. Please keep a copy of this letter for your records. Failure to present the eligibility letter and/or to notify ISAC of a college choice change, as required, may result in the loss of benefits.

The college also has deadlines for requesting payment on a student's behalf. ISAC sets payment request deadlines in late November for fall term; mid-April for spring term and late June for summer term. The college may have earlier deadlines for students to submit documentation of eligibility - you must work with your college's financial aid office for information about their deadline dates.

Changes to your address or college choice [include the term(s) affected] during the 2011-12 academic year must be submitted in writing to ISAC's Deerfield address (listed below), or fax the information to 847.831.8549.

ISAC will notify you via mail if an update is received and/or your college choice or address changes.

You must reapply each academic year. The 2012-13 application will be available in late spring of 2012 on the ISAC College Zone website.
