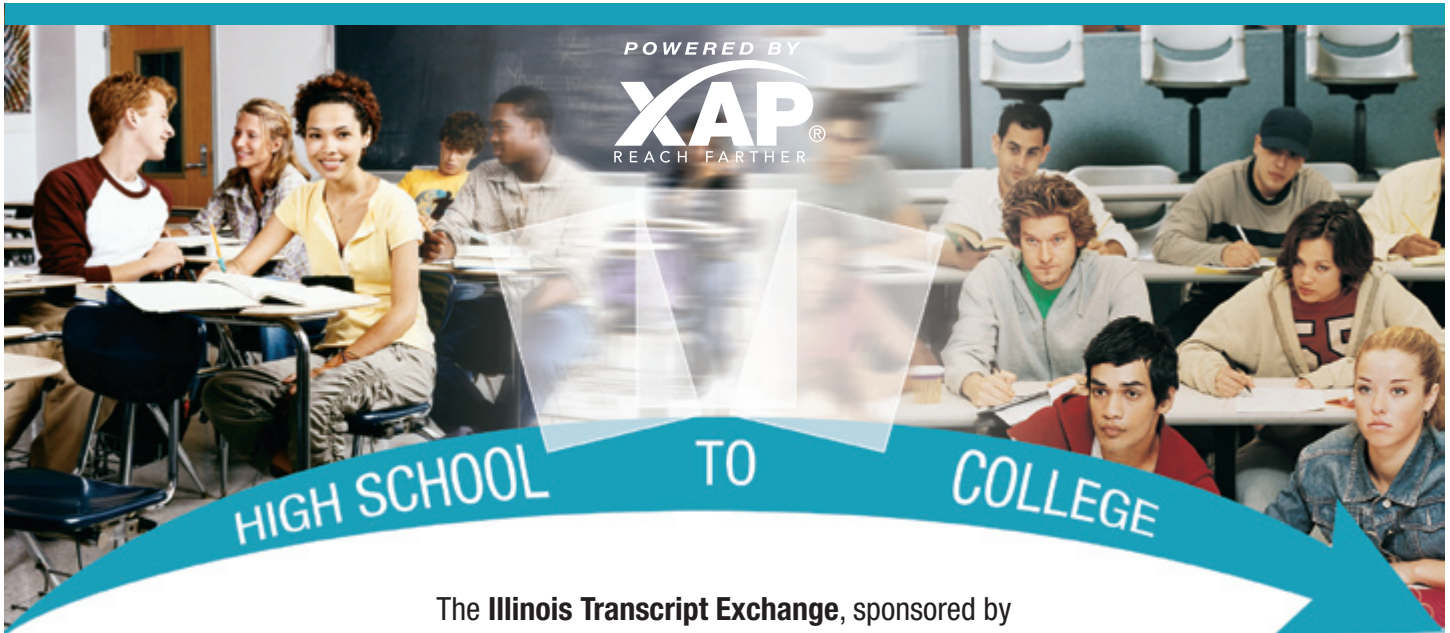




Illinois Transcript Exchange System

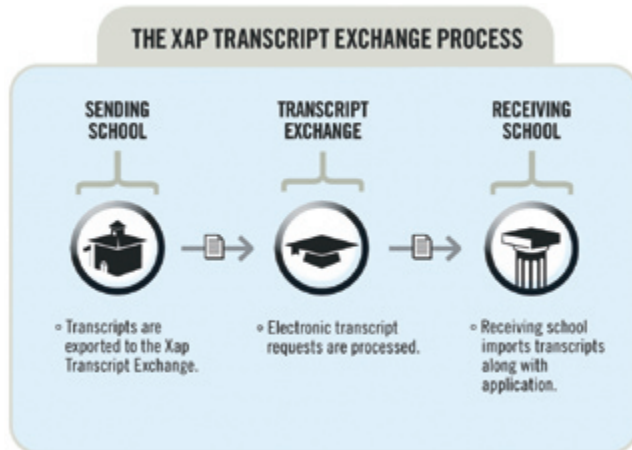

How Does it Work?

An all-new PDX™ Lite software has been developed, which is a universal solution that can be used with any Student Information System (SIS) that can create a transcript. This market-responsive solution enables high school counselors to electronically send PDF images of high school transcripts to colleges and universities as well as sending data to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission (ISAC) for the High School Scholarship Programs (HSSP) in real time.



Download:

Colleges can download selected electronic transcripts in minutes. Mindful of administrators' limited time, set up and training is complete in less than an hour. Administrators can print transcripts of selected students or in batch. In addition, colleges can save electronic transcripts for use in its imaging system.

Process:

This digital package is available to colleges within minutes. Colleges then have up to 90 days to download the transcripts. As a result, colleges can review and process the online application and transcript sooner and more efficiently than with paper documents.

How Secure is the Transcript Exchange?

The Transcript Exchange offers multiple layers of security to safeguard and protect student data. First, the Transcript Exchange uses 128-bit strong SSL encryption for data transmission.

Second, the information is digitally signed so that if any part of a transcript changes either during transmission or through tampering, the entire transcript immediately becomes invalid.

Third, the Transcript Exchange is protected by multiple tiers of state-of-the-art equipment including dual firewalls, smart switches, and physically-isolated databases.
